Parking & Traffic Committee Meeting

October 10, 2019

<u>Call to order:</u> The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bednar at 4:30 p.m.

a) Mrs. Dees confirmed the meeting was properly noticed.

- b) Proposed meeting agenda was approved unanimously.
- c) Minutes of the September 12, 2019, meeting approved unanimously.
- d) Mike Ziarnek was welcomed as an ex officio member of the committee.

Ongoing Business:

- a) JSG spalling and seam repairs
 - 1. Down payment was made and work on the top floor will begin soon.
- b) Consultant support
 - 1. Mrs. Dees began working with Mr. Darden on the CRA end-of-the-year report and asked the individual committee members to solicit and set up community meetings in their respective industries.
- c) Baylen traffic flow change request
 - 1. Traffic flow patterns and changes fall under the purview of the city. Members of city staff indicated the city is not in favor of angled parking.
- d) Citation rate increases
 - 1. DIB approved the rate increases suggested by the parking committee and it will be placed on the CRA report as a recommendation for change.
- e) Interlocal agreement on hold due to city attorneys' overburdened schedules.
- f) Garden Street pay stations
 - 1. Motion made by Mr. Zimmern to approve request for pay stations to replace lollipops as recommended by Mrs. Dees. Ms. Young provided the second. Motion carried 4-1 with Mr. Lehman dissenting.
- g) JSG customer parking signs
 - 1. At the recommendation of Mr. Elebash, DIB provided five "customer only" signs on the first floor.

New Business

- a) JSG elevator repair
 - 1. Bagby Elevator Company recommended modernization of the two elevators for a total cost of \$112,000.

- 2. Staff will obtain further information as to the cost of replacing versus repairing the elevators and how long each option will last.
- b) East Garden District FDOT request
 - 1. Mr. Fitzpatrick with FDOT requested the elimination of one parking spot at the northwest corner of Jefferson and Garden to increase walkability in conjunction with landscape improvements that are being made.
 - 2. Mr. Roesch moved approval of the one-space elimination in exchange for increased walkability. Seconded by Ms. Young. Motion carried 3-2, Mr. Zimmern abstaining and Mr. Lehman dissenting.
- c) End-of-year CRA parking report previously discussed.
